Submit new or revised syllabus via KIWAS: Friday 22 February

Enter course occasion in KIWAS: Friday 15 March

When applying for funding directly from the Course and programme committee, please include the following:

- Form to apply for funding for freestanding doctoral courses
- Budget and motivation, if the course exceeds 3 HEC or if applying for a higher amount than the specified standard.
- The latest course analysis (if the course has been given previously).

Workshops in Blended pedagogical models for teaching and learning with Canvas

In November and January two separate workshops were arranged on the theme *Blended pedagogical models for teaching and learning with Canvas*. The workshops were open for anyone involved in doctoral courses interested in learning how blended learning can be applied to their course with the use of Canvas, our new learning management system (LMS). The participants were given the opportunity to experience blended pedagogical models and the use of Canvas from the student's perspective as well as reflecting on how to implement these models and tools into their own course.
