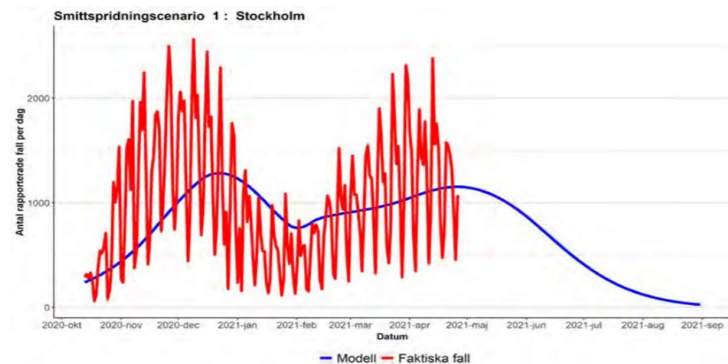
Covid-19 and teaching
