

Dangerous goods and biological samples allowed to be transported on the Scientific Samples Shuttle (provided the sample is correctly packaged and labeled):

Dry ice (carbon dioxide) UN1845

Liquid nitrogen, UN1977, only in a so-called “dry shipper”

If the sample requires liquid nitrogen for transportation, a “dry shipper” must be used. Contact World Courier for more information.

Exempt medical sample

- Samples without living microorganisms, for example antibodies and DNA/RNA.
- Human samples or animal samples with minimal risk of containing pathogens, for example blood or saliva from healthy donors.

Biological substance category B, UN3373

- Stems of microorganisms that don't meet the criteria for biological substance category A, UN2814, i.e. most microorganisms in risk group 1 and 2.
- Human samples or animal samples where it is uncertain whether they contain pathogens or not.

Exempt radioactive sample, limited quantity, UN2910

Read "Lista med tillåtna isotoper och mängd" and contact KI radiation protection expert Mats Stenström, at least 7 days before transport for detailed instructions on packaging and labeling.

Dangerous goods and biological samples NOT allowed to be transported on the Scientific Samples Shuttle:

Biological substance category A (infectious substance which can cause disease in humans or animals) UN2814/ UN2900

Biological substances that can cause permanent impairment or life threatening disease, see list Biological substance category A. Transport of such substances must be booked separately.
