Chief Editor Vesna Todorovic: Introducing Nature Cardiovascular Research

Biosketch:

Vesna Todorovic joined the Nature Portfolio in 2014 as Nature Communications editor. In 2017 she transferred to Nature, where she became responsible for the journal's content on cardiovascular biology and metabolism. She launched as Chief Editor of Nature Cardiovascular Research in January 2021.

Vesna holds a PhD in molecular biology from the University of Belgrade, Serbia, and the International Centre for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology in Trieste, Italy. As a research scientist, she worked at the New York University School of Medicine, first as a post-doctoral researcher in the laboratory of Daniel Rifkin and then as a faculty member of the Department of Cell Biology. While at NYU, her research interests included studies of TGF β bioavailability and activity in cardiovascular development and disease. In 2012 she moved to Mount Sinai School of Medicine as a Staff Scientist, where she investigated the novel molecular pathways involved in the development of thoracic aortic aneurism in mouse models of Marfan syndrome.
