

# Scientific Samples Shuttle

This may be transported with **Scientific samples shuttle**:

<b>Dryice, UN1845</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Samples packed in dryice. May also contain Biological substance category B, UN3373 &amp; Exempt medical sample.</li></ul>
<b>Biological subject category B, UN3373</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Human or animal samples when it is uncertain whether they contain pathogens.</li></ul>
<b>Radioactive exempt sample, limited amount of material, UN2910</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read "List of permitted isotopes and amount" and contact KI's radiation protection expert Sofia Skyttner no later than 7 days before transport for instructions and labeling. Also contact CLX.</li></ul>
<b>Exempt medical sample</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Human samples with minimal probability of pathogens. Similar animal samples are called exempt veterinary samples.</li></ul>
<b>Liquid Nitrogen - UN1977</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• When transporting liquid nitrogen, a "dry shipper" container is required. A "dry shipper" is a container specially designed to transport biological samples in liquid nitrogen.</li></ul>
<b>Biological substance Category A UN2814 / UN2900. (Infectious substance affecting humans or animals)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• These types of samples may NOT be sent with the Scientific samples shuttle.</li></ul>
