Procurements During the Summer

Purchasing and public procurement may have longer lead times during the summer due to reduced staffing levels, especially during the industrial holidays (weeks 28–32). Our suppliers also take holidays during this period, which can affect planning.

We therefore recommend that you plan your purchases well in advance, preferably before June, to ensure that you receive your goods and services on time. You can already send a <u>request for procurement support</u> to <u>inkopupphandling@ki.se</u> to get help with your purchases.

Please bear in mind that you will need to be available during the procurement process to answer questions and provide input.

New Framework Agreement for Protective Ventilation Inspections

Reference Number: 2-4499/2023

KI has entered into a framework agreement with Comfort-Control AB for the inspection of protective ventilation from 1 April 2024.

The agreement covers annual and regular functional checks of ventilated workspaces, installation inspections for new equipment, airflow control in safety cabinets, and corrective actions.
