

Classes of dangerous goods (i.e. all goods that have a UN-number) and biological samples allowed on the Scientific Samples Shuttle, provided that the packaging and labelling is correct:

*Dry Ice (UN1845)*

*Liquid Nitrogen (UN1977) in a "dry shipper"*  
If your sample requires liquid nitrogen for shipping you must use a "dry shipper".

*Exempt human specimens and Exempt animal specimens*

- Samples without living microorganisms.  
Example: antibodies and DNA/RNA.
- Human or animal specimens that have a minimal likelihood of containing pathogens as, for example, blood or saliva from healthy donors.

*Biological substance category B (UN3373)*

- Stocks of microorganisms that do not meet the criteria under UN2814, that is, most micro-organisms in risk group 1 and 2.
- Human or animal specimens where there is uncertainty whether they contain pathogens.

*Radioactive excepted package, limited quantity of material (UN2910)*

**Dangerous goods and biological samples NOT allowed on the Scientific Samples Shuttle:**

*Biological Substance Category A (Infectious Substance affecting humans/animals, UN2814/UN2900)*

Biological substances that may cause permanent disabilities or life-threatening conditions, see List of Category A Substances\*. Transportation of such samples must be booked separately.






## Karolinska Hospital Solna, 1<sup>st</sup> stop

## Why?


The commuter bus does not have license to transport dangerous goods. But the shuttle car does.




## KI Campus Flemingsberg, 1<sup>st</sup> stop
