

REACH: import / import of smaller quantities (under 100 kg) of chemicals for personal use

Imports/purchases from other countries outside the EU and EEA

When importing substances or mixtures that are

- classified as dangerous according to CLP
- to be registered in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH) (even if not classified as dangerous) (<u>https://eur-lex.europa.eu/legal-content/EN/TXT/?uri=CELEX%3A32006R1907</u>) is included in a mixture at a level that contributes to the classification being classified as dangerous according to CLP
- These substances shall be reported to the ECHA (European Chemicals Agency) Classification and Labeling Inventory (<u>https://echa.europa.eu/regulations/clp/cl-inventory/notification-to-the-cl-inventory</u>).

If you manufacture or submit a reportable chemical product to Sweden and the annual volume per product is at least 100 kg, you must register the products in the **products register** (<u>https://www.kemi.se/en/products-register</u>).

Entry/purchase from other EU and EEA countries
