Change in parking fees 2017 – updated information

We have previously informed about a change in parking tariff from April 1st, 2017, and we would like to take this opportunity to clarify the background to these changes. Enclosed is also an updated price list which has been amended with the correct prices for Campus Flemingsberg.

The parking tariffs were last updated in 2013 and a revision should be done approximately every 3rd year. The new tariff equals a 10% increase across all our campuses in Stockholm. The average cost of parking on our campuses is based on the market price in the area and Stockholm Stad will also be increasing their tariffs during 2017. As a part of adjusting the prices we are also introducing a flat rate on Campus Solna.

Akademiska Hus is consistently working towards decreasing the amount of cars on campus. Because of this a decision has been made to keep the parking around the edges of campus, towards the railway, and in the garage below Biomedicum. In addition to the newly built car park, Skruven on Tomtebodavägen, there is a second car park planned to be built next to it. Moving forward Akademiska Hus wants to encourage a green outdoor environment with natural meeting places and walking paths in order to increase the well-being on campus.

In line with our work towards a greener campus we are encouraging all visitors to, and employees at, Campus Solna to park in the multi-storey car parks on Tomtebodavägen. In the new car park, Skruven, you have access to charging stations for electrical cars and a locked bicycle room. The outdoor gravel car park on Fogdevreten will remain open for the rest of the year before closing to make room for 440 flats for scholars and professors. The old car park on Tomtebodavägen 7-9 will remain open. As part of the flat rate on Campus Solna, we are adjusting the prices on those two car parks to match the rest of campus.

Even though this means an increase of more than 10% in some places we see many benefits with a flat rate on campus. It will increase flexibility when the same ticket can be used across campus. The development on Campus Solna also means that the precondition for cheap outdoor parking is limited. Because of the increased focus on outdoor environment and campus development there is no longer any cheap land to lease for parking spaces. The introduction of capitation on Campus Solna is in line with the target of reducing ground parking on campus and encourages the use of car parks at Tomtebodavägen.

Those with a staff pass and who pay their fee according to the staff rate can use the same ticket for all Akademiska Hus campuses in Stockholm.

Annual passes will be on sale for the current price up until March 31st 2017.
