

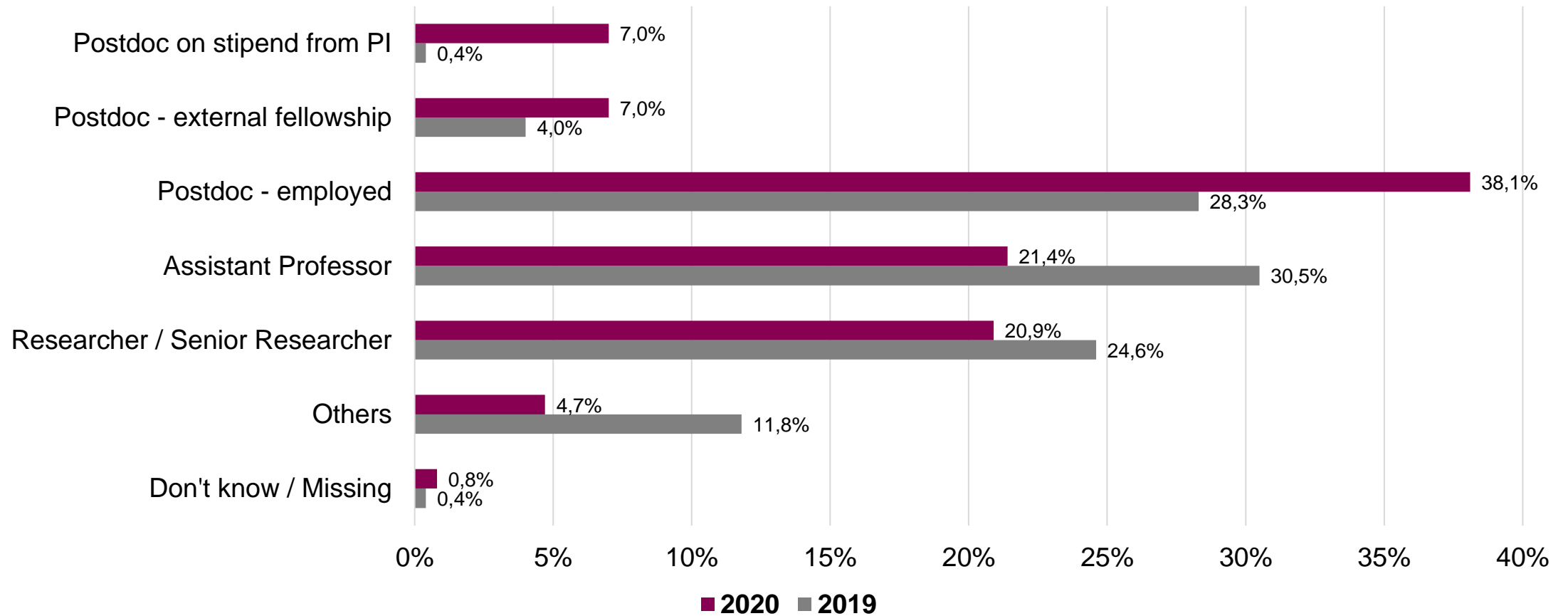

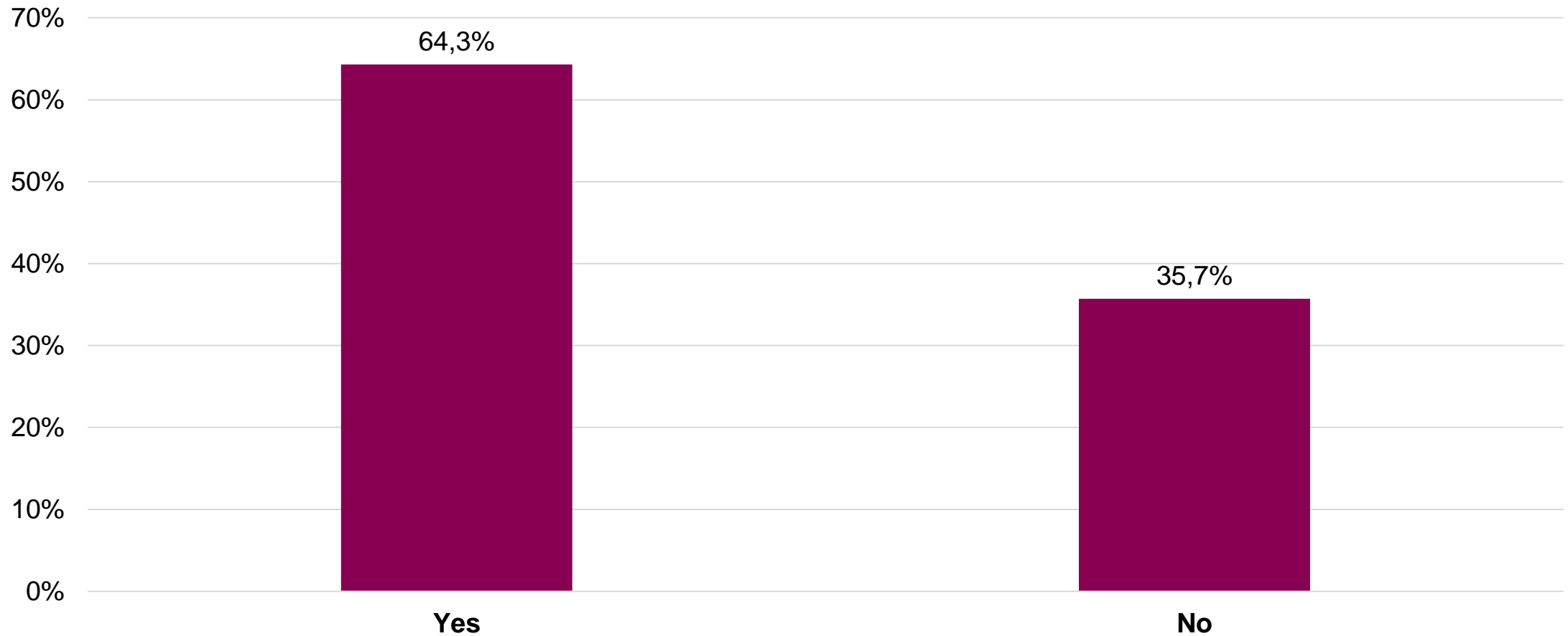
Junior Faculty Survey-2020

- Responded: **383** (response rate **19.71%**)
 - ~ 60% women
 - ~ 60% non-Swedish
 - ~ 52% postdocs

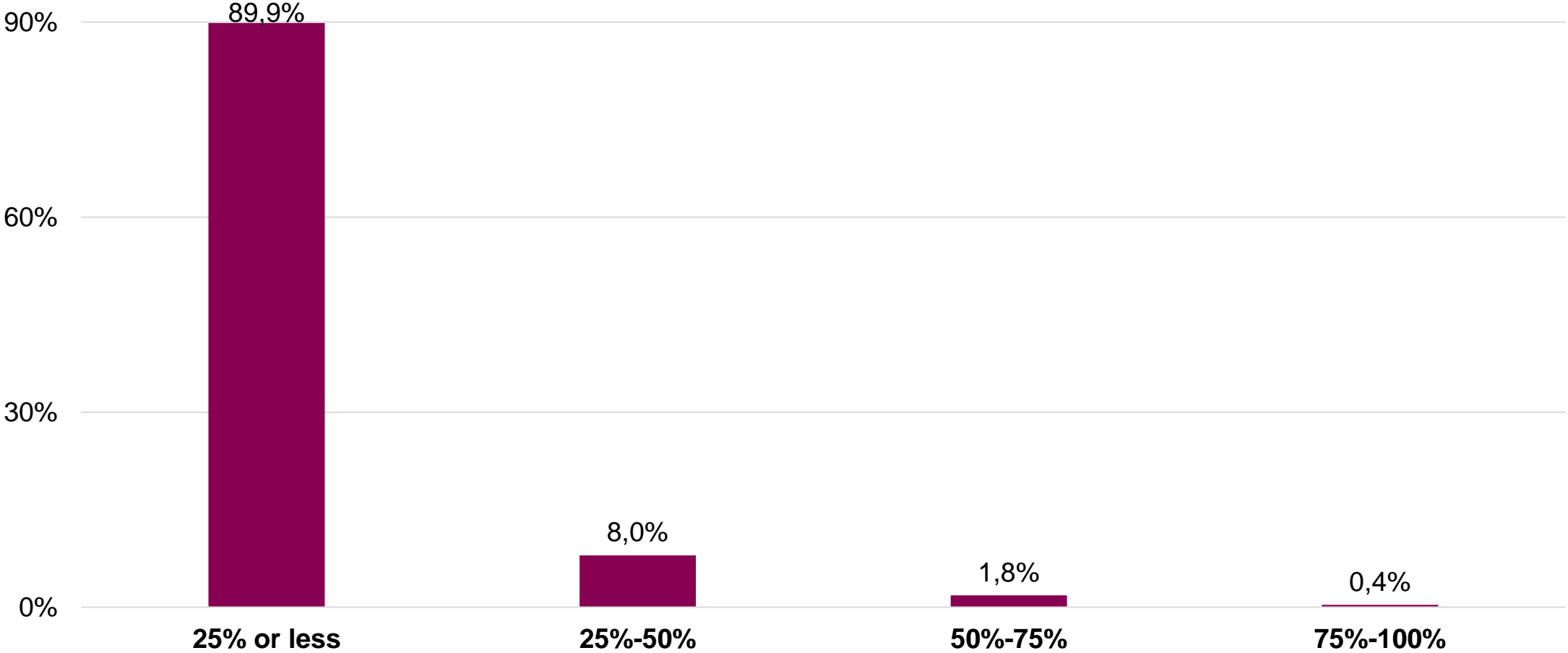
What is your current position according to your contract?



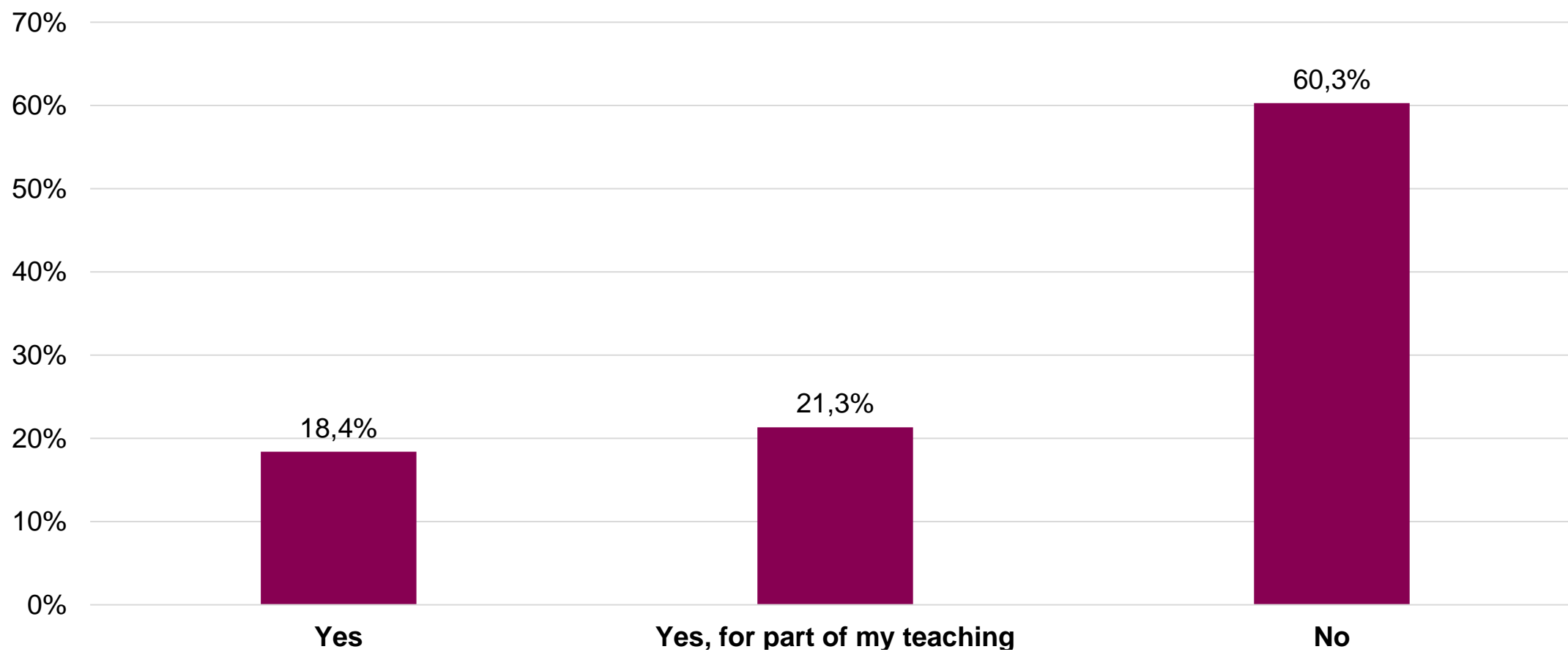
Are you involved in teaching activities at Karolinska Institutet?



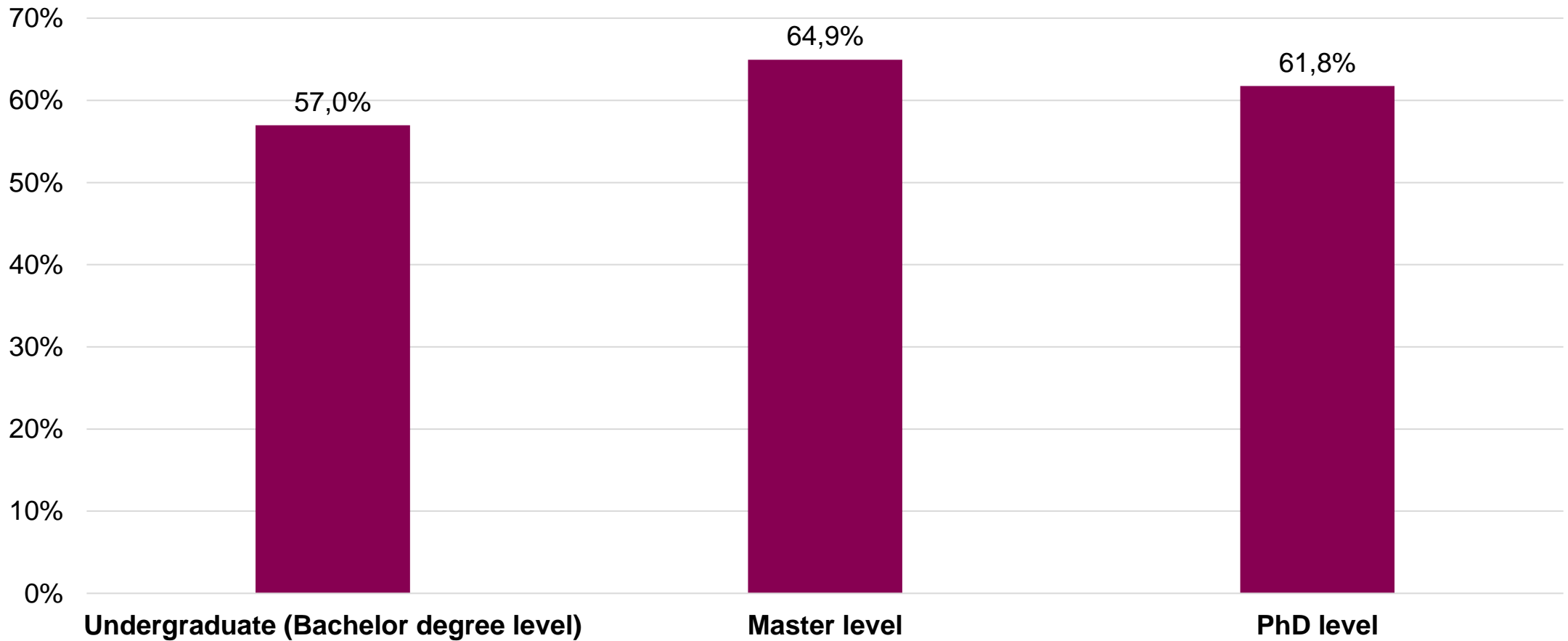
What percentage of your time do you estimate you spend teaching?



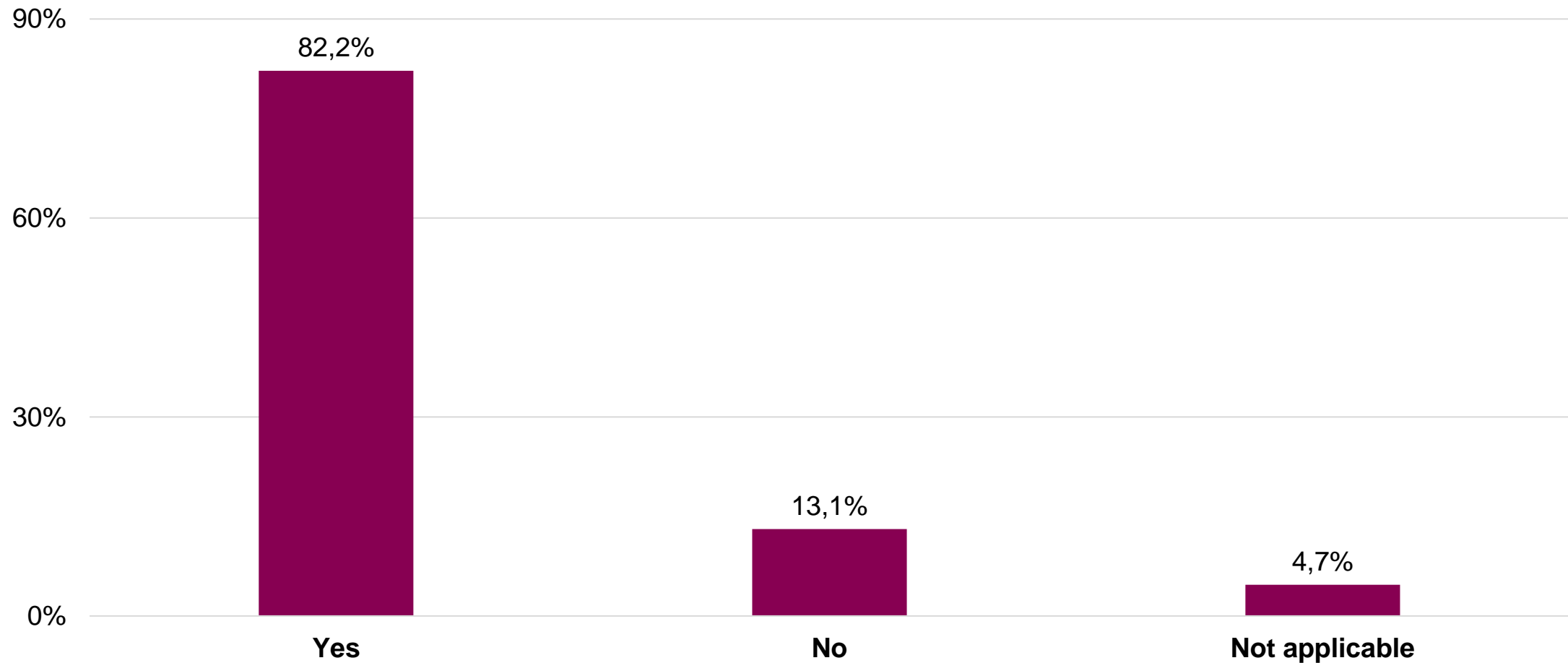
Do you receive compensation (payment) for teaching?



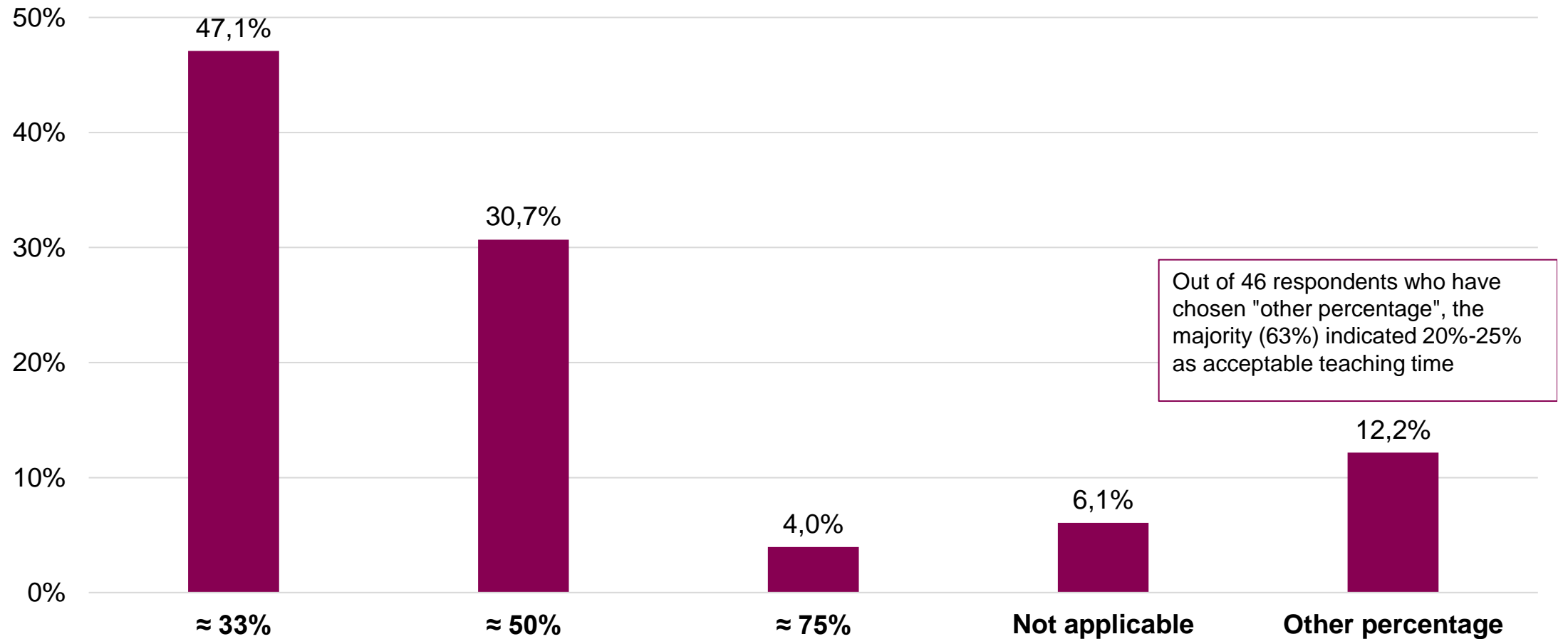

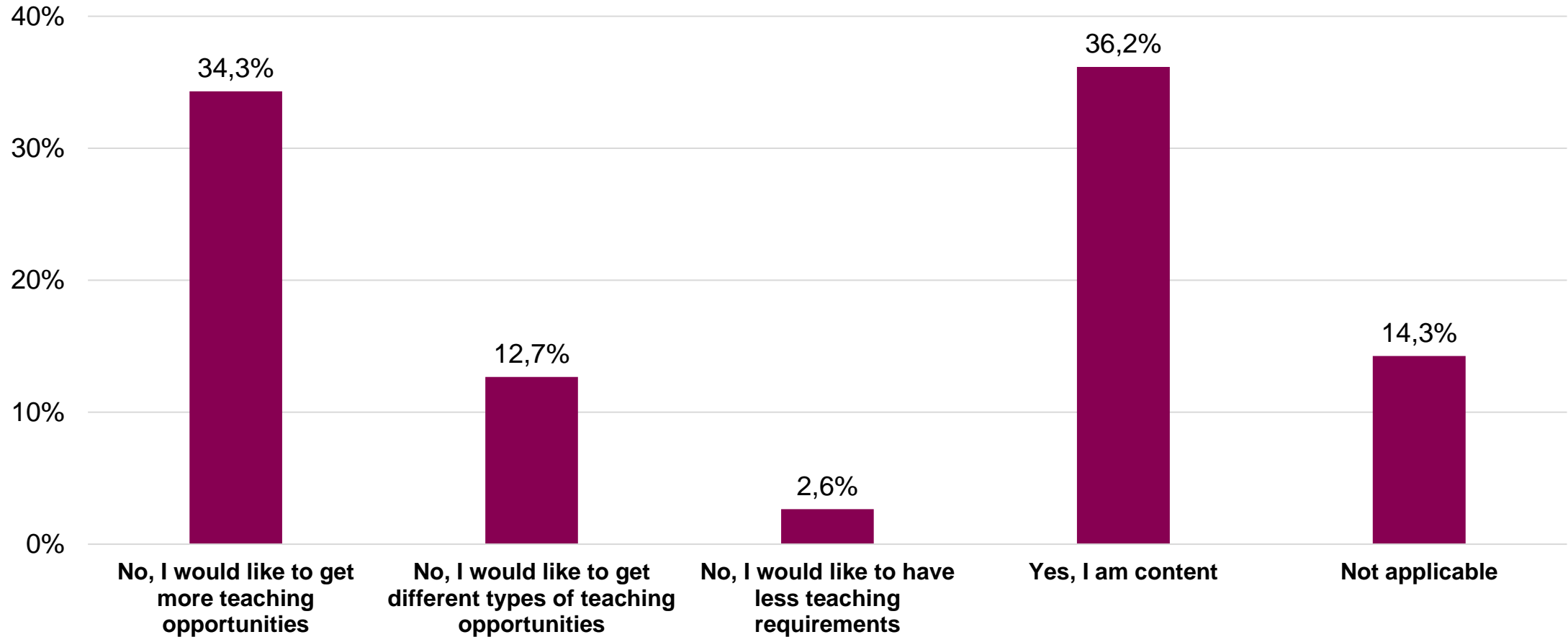

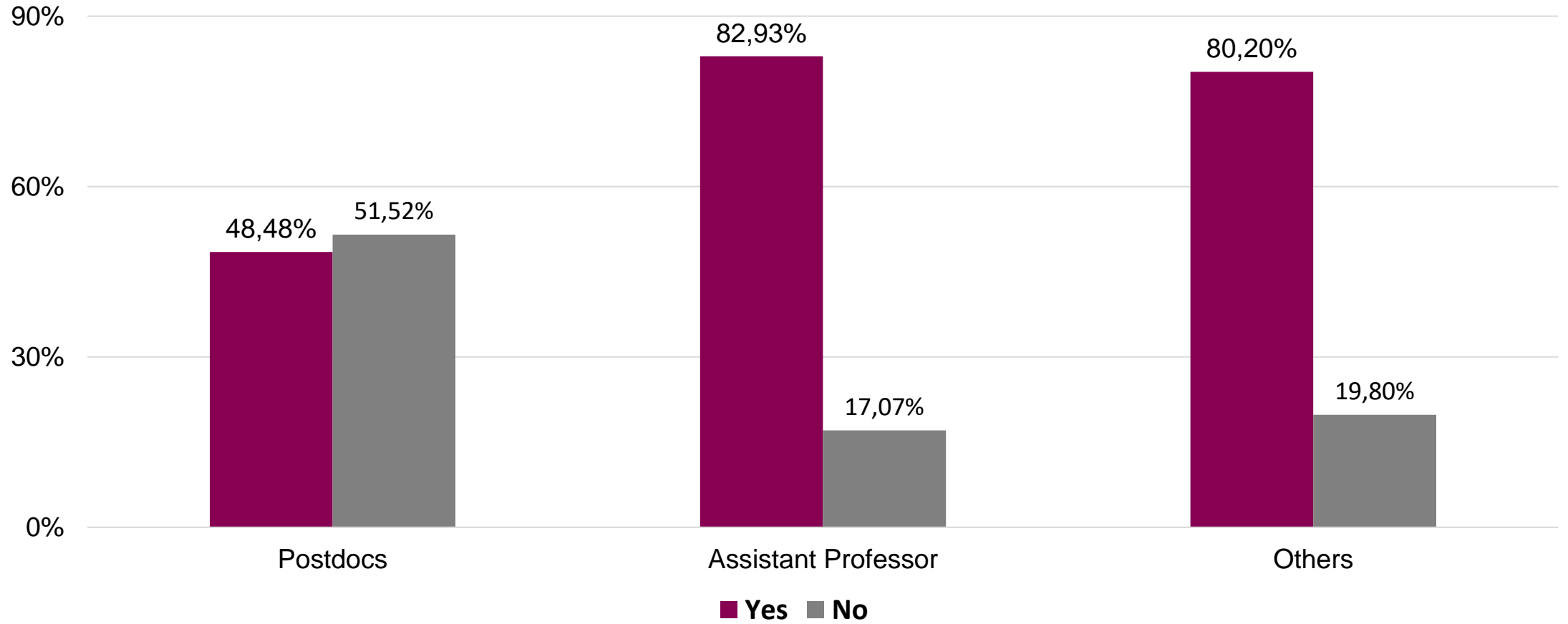
- Postdoc – affiliated: stipend from PI (Postdocstipendiat med KI-stipendium) (n=27)

Assistant Professors (Forskarassistent/Biträdande Lektor) (n=82)

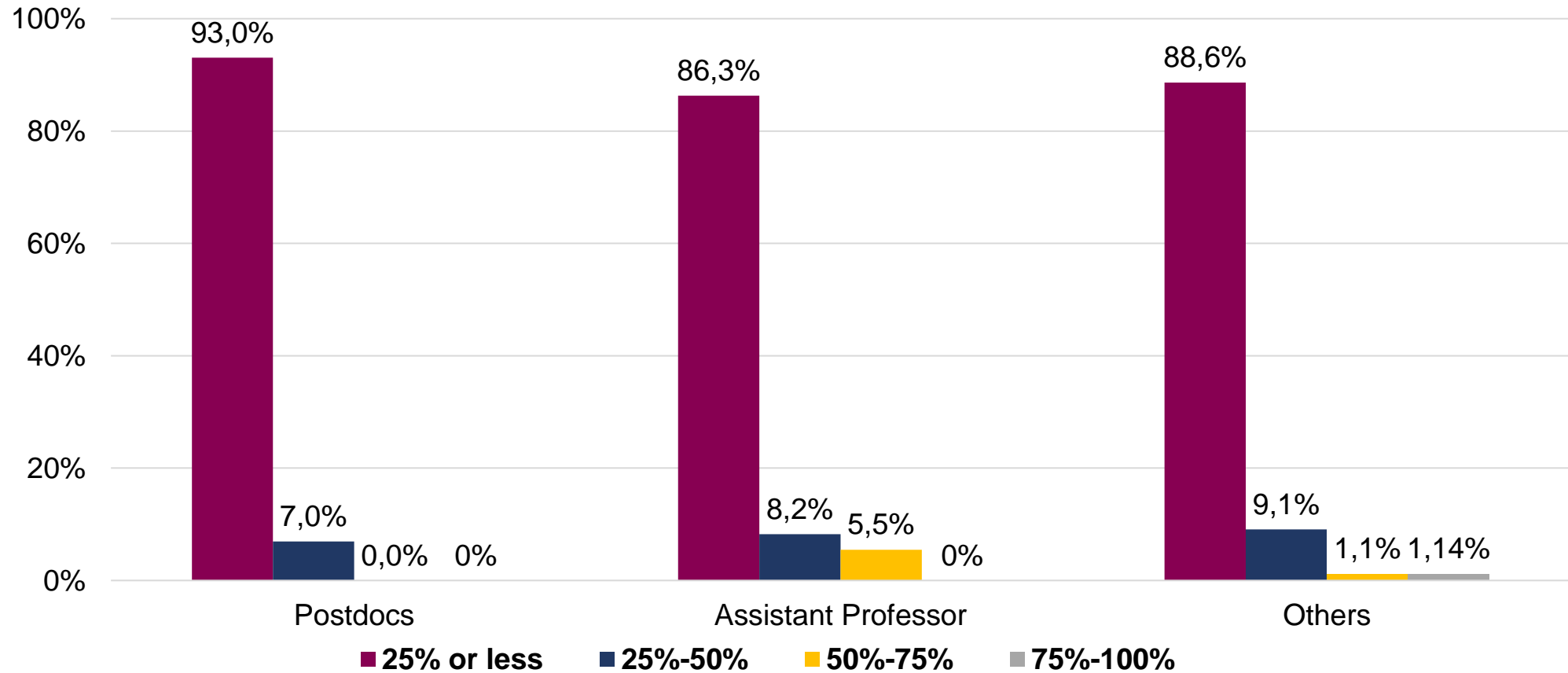
Others (n=101)

- Do not know their position according to contract (n=3)

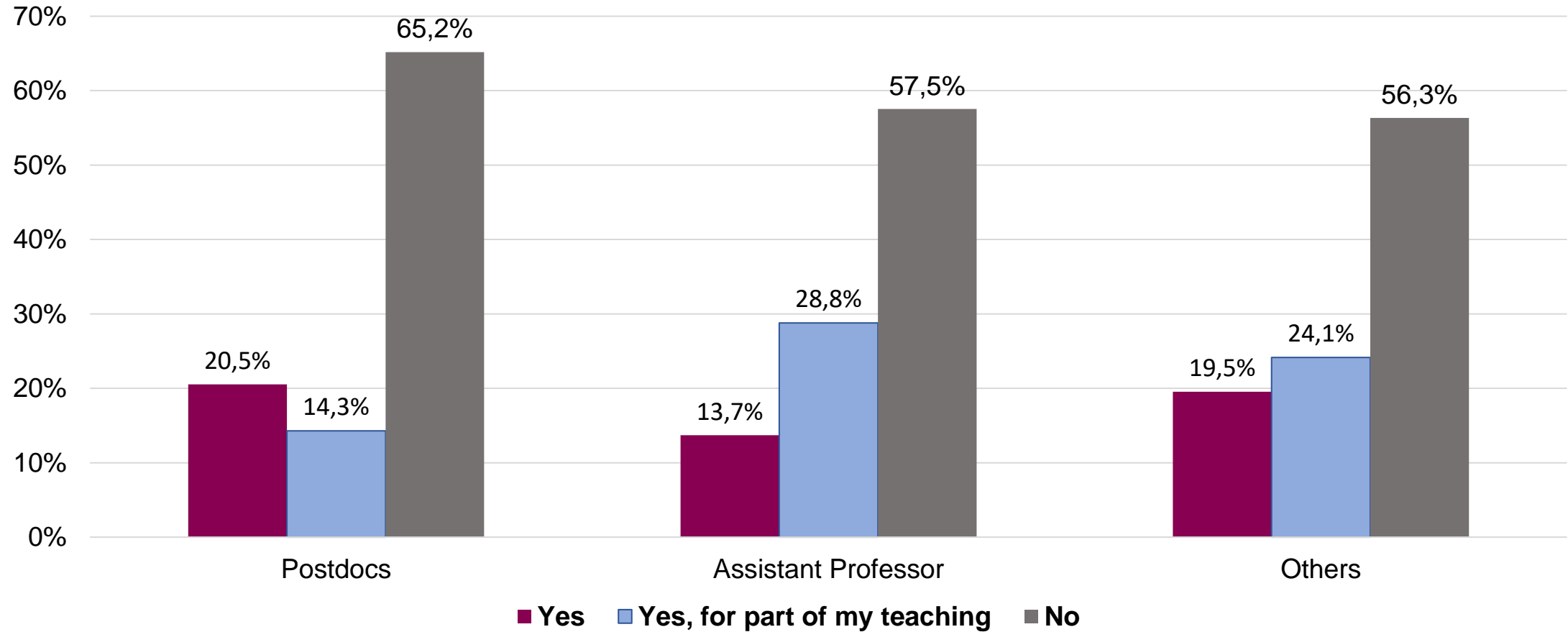
Are you involved in teaching activities at Karolinska Institutet?



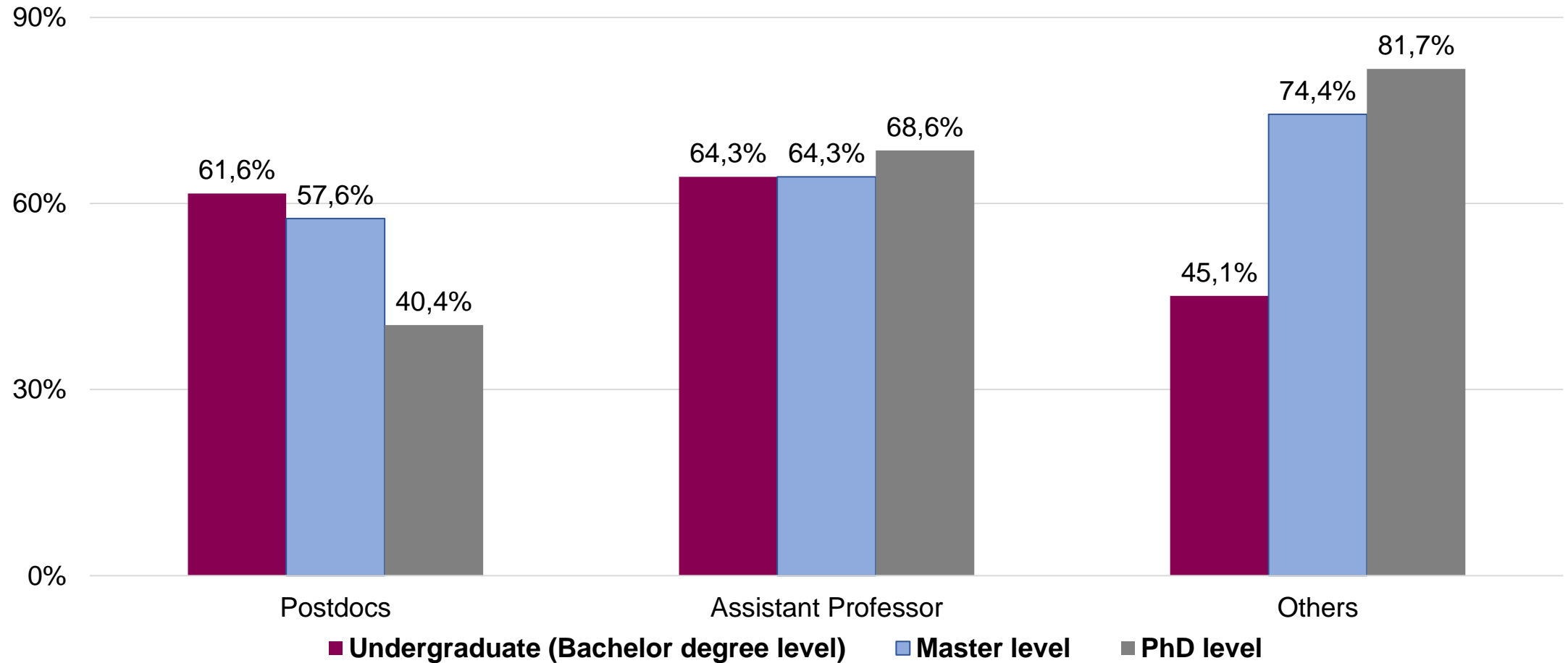
What percentage of your time do you estimate you spend teaching?



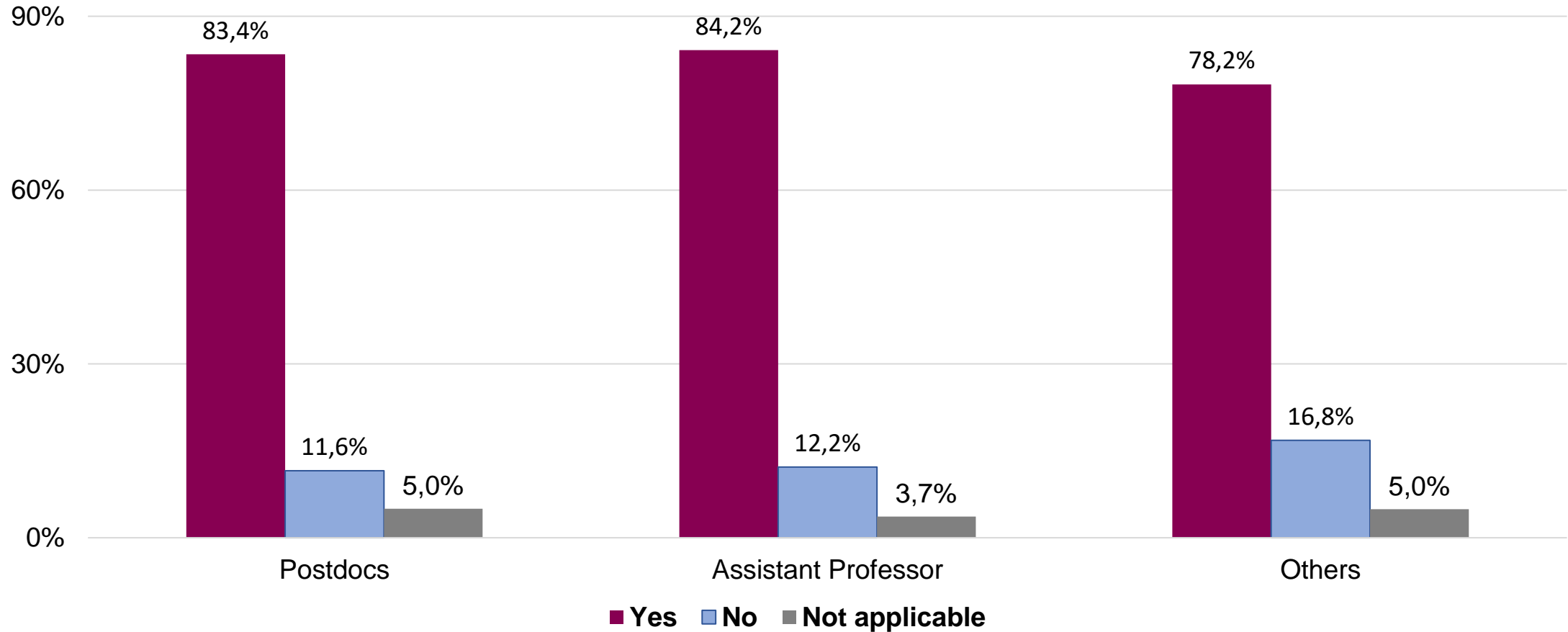
Do you receive compensation (payment) for teaching?

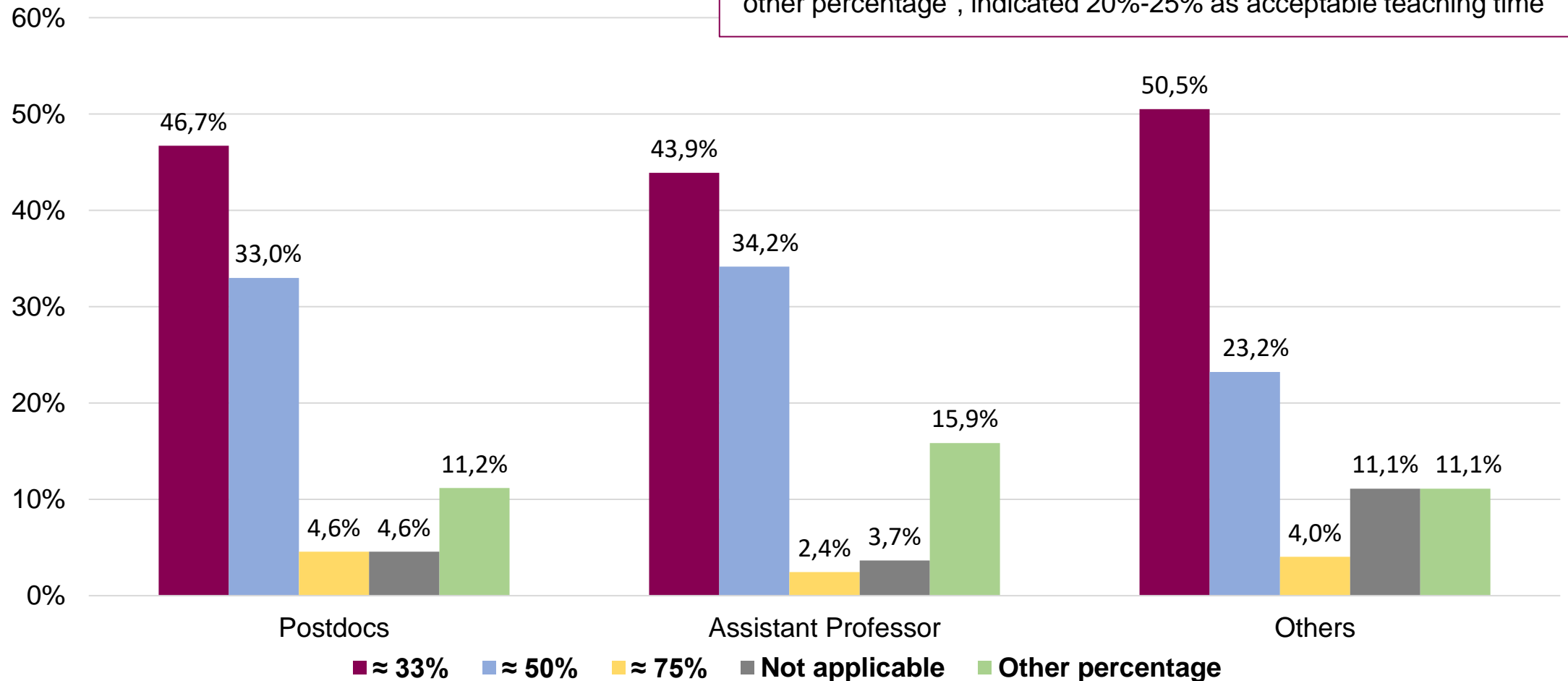
