

Malin Ernberg, DDS, PhD

Malin Ernberg is professor and head of the Division of Oral Diagnostics and Rehabilitation at the Department of Dental Medicine, and senior consultant in orofacial pain and jaw function at the University Dental Clinic, Karolinska Institutet, where she also received her dental degree and PhD.

Professor Ernberg's research focuses on the role of intramuscular release of algescic substances for pain mediation in chronic muscle pain with the ultimate goal to find individualized treatments specifically targeted against the pathogenesis. She has co-authored more than 100 original papers, review papers and book chapters.

Professor Ernberg has vast experience of teaching and supervision of undergraduate, master and PhD students.

Between 2011 and 2012 she was the President of the Neuroscience Group of the International Association for Dental Research (IADR) and between 2013 and 2016 the President of the Swedish Pain Society, the national chapter of the International Association for Pain (IASP), and the Swedish Councillor of the European Pain Federation (EFIC).
