The subsequent seminar in the afternoon for PHD students will apply some of these concepts to a range of real-world interventions.

**21 March 2019** This one-day seminar for PHD students will provide a practical introduction to challenges and solutions in the development, evaluation and implementation of complex interventions for health. It will involve a combination of lectures, worked examples and group-work tasks.
